

Speech to text using a smartphone

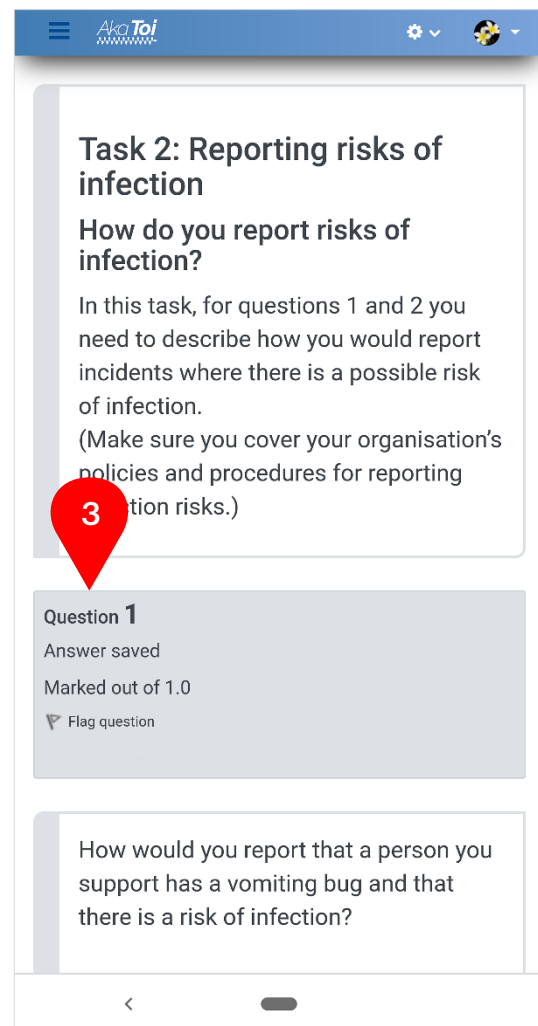
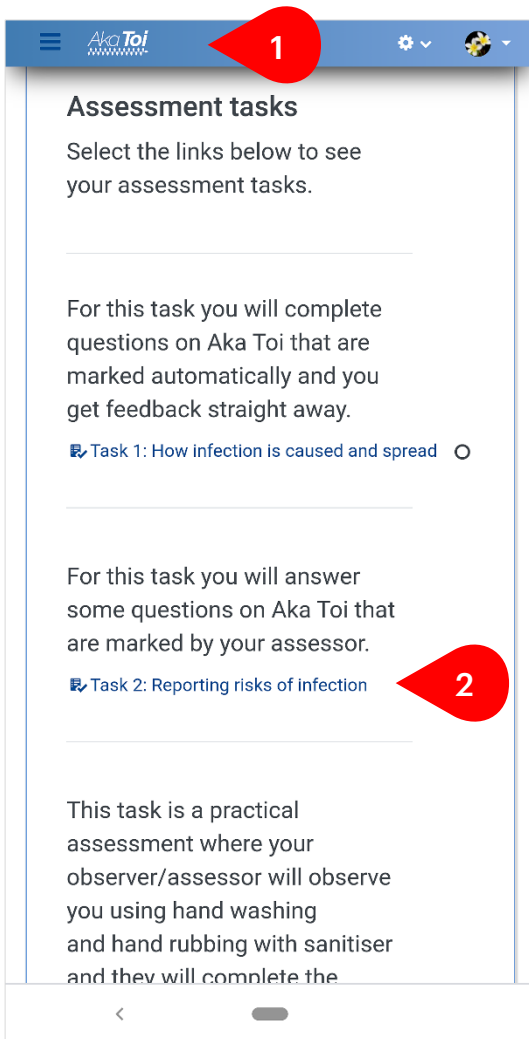


Although speech to text can be used in Aka Toi, it is not a function of Aka Toi so we are unable to offer technical support.



We have tested with Android and iPhones and this guide is based on this experience answering Online questions tasks. If your experience is not the same, to find out exactly how the speech to text function works with your smartphone, we advise Googling or contact your phone retailer.

1. From the browser on your smartphone, login to Aka Toi.
2. Navigate to the module and then the Assessment section with the task you want to complete.
3. Navigate to the Assessment task and scroll to the question.



4. Tap in the answer field to bring up the keyboard.

You will see a microphone icon somewhere around the keyboard, eg above right or bottom left.



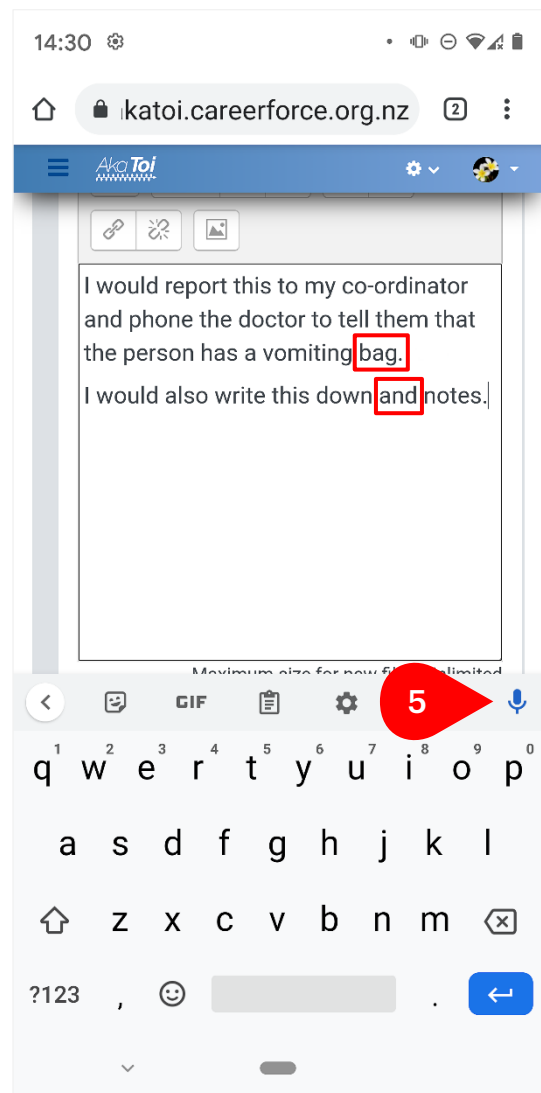
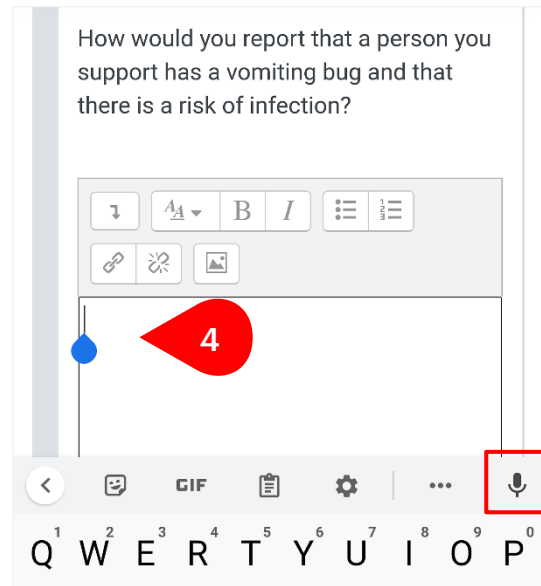
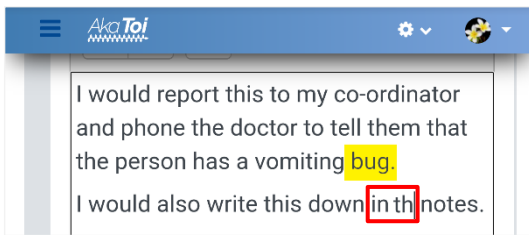
If you don't see the microphone icon, your phone likely does not have speech to text functionality.

(The first time you use your microphone you might be asked for access permission.)

5. Tap the microphone icon, then speak clearly. As you speak your words will be typed into the answer field.

Tap the microphone to stop.

Check the text and edit where words have been misheard by the smartphone. Use the keyboard to edit your text as required.



i Speak the punctuation to add it, eg say:

Fullstop	.	Question mark	?
Comma	,	Exclamation mark	!
Dash	-	Semi-colon	;

New line – this will start a new line but might also stop the microphone.

Experiment with what works with your smartphone.
