This short programme is for Support Workers who have already achieved the New Zealand Certificate in Health & Wellbeing (Social and Community) (Level 4) and are in roles that see them working with people from across sectors, that would benefit from some additional skills and/or capabilities to support the work they do, or have perhaps changed employers and have a different focus to their work.

Expected Outcomes

The programme includes recognising and developing the following competencies in your staff:

- Being able to demonstrate the philosophy, purpose, benefits and role of quality assurance diversional therapy.
- The ability to provide assessment, development, and implementation of diversional therapy care plans for individuals and groups suffering grief and loss.

Prerequisites

Learners must have completed the New Zealand Certificate in Health and Wellbeing (Social and Community) (Level 4) with strands in Community Facilitation, Community Health Work, Mental Health and Addiction, or Social Services (delivered as Careerforce apprenticeship programmes) or completed another New Zealand Certificate in Health and Wellbeing (Level 4) or above programme with Careerforce. Enrolments will be accepted where an approved programme has been completed with another provider.

Online learning and assessments will be completed via Careerforce's online learning platform, Aka Toi.
