Foundation packages for Careerforce Gateway programmes

These foundation packages are designed to make selecting unit standards simple. They provide a foundation of core knowledge at Level 2 and Level 3 to give students experience of the health, youth, and cleaning sectors, while gaining 15 to 20 credits towards NCEA.

Units within these packages will go towards completing a full qualification if students later move into workplace training.

Students who complete a package will receive a Careerforce Certificate recognising their achievement.

These targeted foundation packages have been added to the existing Careerforce Gateway 'Engage' (7 credits), 'Explore' (12 credits) and 'Experience' (23 credits) options.
